Scope and Sequence

Connecting Math Concepts, Level C places a strong emphasis on higher-order thinking. Students learn a variety of mapping techniques for relating problem solving to real-life situations. With word problems, measurement, money, time, and various projects, students graphically represent information before they attempt to calculate an answer. The

detailed instruction leads both teachers and students to develop positive feelings about problem solving. In addition, instruction covers place value, geometry, estimation, and calculator use.

Concepts and computational skills are also taught for regrouping, multiplication, division, and fractions. The Scope and Sequence Chart shows where each track or major topic begins and where it ends.

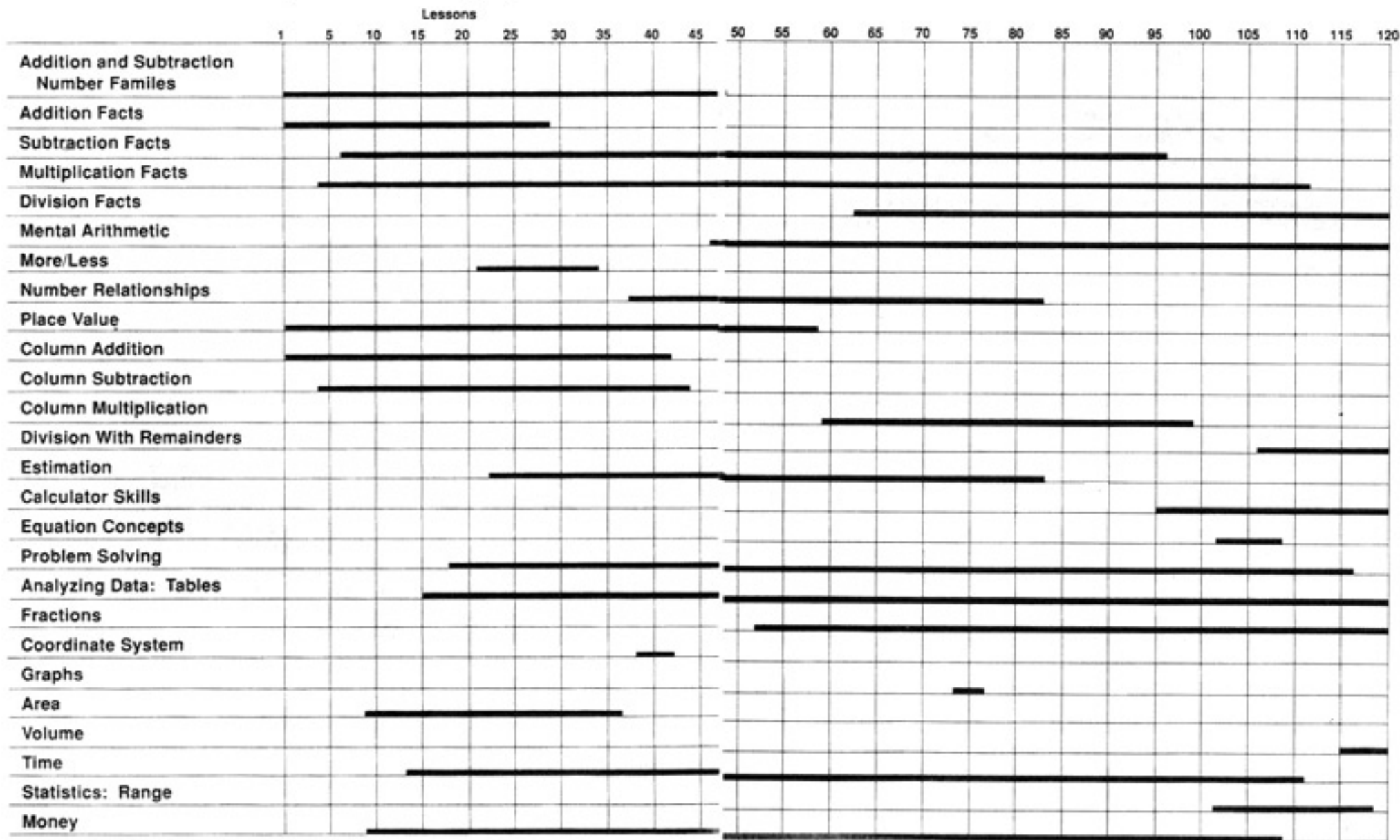


FIGURE 2.7 Scope and Sequence Chart from *Connecting Math Concepts Level C*. Reprinted with permission of the McGraw-Hill Companies, Inc.
